On Monday, April 15th, the contractor will begin installing a new storm sewer under the street pavement from Grove Avenue working west to Forest Avenue. During this time, the contractor will also be replacing the water services for the residences on the north side of the street to avoid conflicts with the new storm sewer. This work will be completed by Friday, April 26th.

During the day while the contractor is completing the work, Burlington Avenue will be inaccessible from Grove Avenue to Forest Avenue with barricades and road closed signs set up at either end of the block. At night, a section of the block will remain closed and inaccessible where the contractor has finished work for that day. This overnight closure area will move as the work progresses down the block but, while it is in place, any driveways located within this area will not be accessible. All efforts will be made to minimize this period and, during this time, it is not anticipated that any driveway will be inaccessible for more than four days. Overnight street parking restrictions will not be enforced on Grove Avenue and Forest Avenue to provide an area to leave vehicles while driveways are inaccessible.

The water services for the residences on the north side of the street (8824, 8828, 8834, and 8844 Burlington Avenue) will be replaced from water main to service box during this time. While the connection is being transferred from the old service to the new service, these residents will be without water for a period of time not expected to exceed two hours. Notice will be provided to each residence at least 24 hours in advance of any water shutdown.
