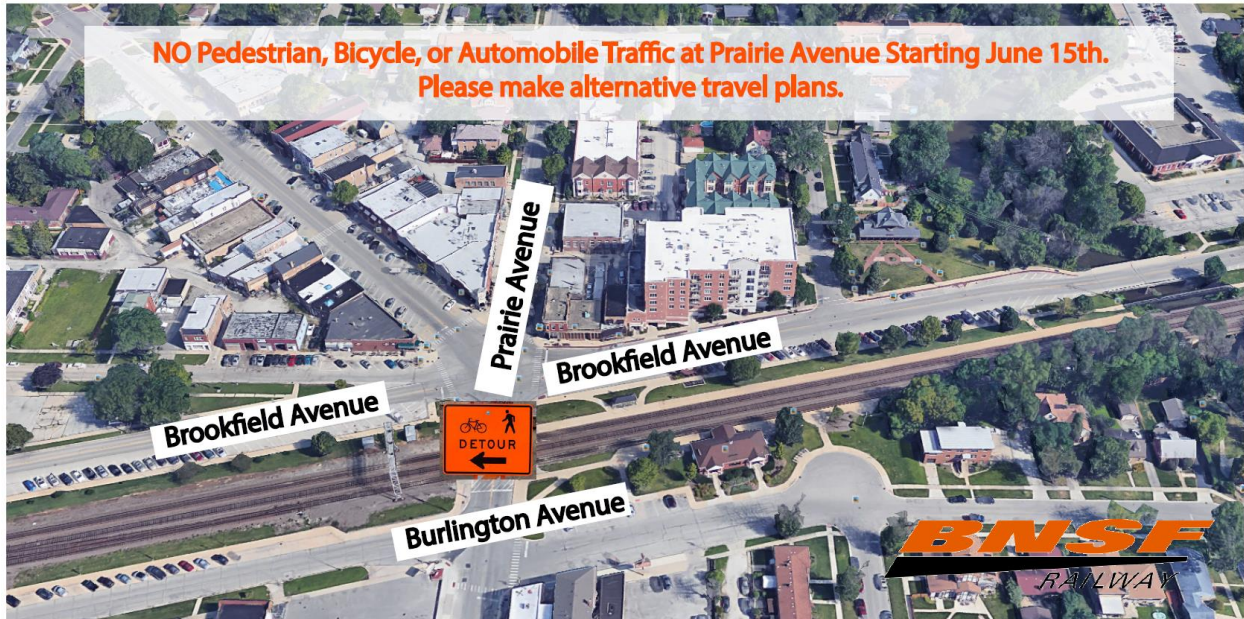


The Prairie Avenue Railroad Crossing will be Closed

The Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) Railway will begin work on the Prairie Avenue crossing, between Brookfield Avenue, and Burlington Avenue from June 15th to June 23rd, 2018. **There will be no pedestrian, bicycle, or automobile traffic allowed to cross the train tracks at this location during this construction.** The crossing at Maple Avenue will still be open and is the recommended alternate route for pedestrian and vehicular traffic. Signs will be posted throughout the general area.



Commuters, are encouraged to utilize the Congress Park Station to the west, or the Hollywood Station which is ADA accessible to the east. ADA customers in need of transportation to the nearest accessible station should call, 312-322-7366.

Please use caution near work zones. The Village of Brookfield is committed to safety and it is the Police Department's main priority. Police will be providing extra manpower for traffic control during peak traffic times at the Maple Avenue crossing. Police officers will be watching out for pedestrian safety and strictly enforcing any trespassing along the tracks. Please do NOT attempt to walk across the tracks anywhere along the route during this period... Taking a shortcut is not worth risking your life!
